Always Come to Class Prepared - Whether you are at home or in school, a successful class depends, upon YOU! You are required to bring your all of your materials to class everyday, unless otherwise notified.

Classwork - All work will be completed during our class period. You should not have homework but may need to complete some work outside of our class time.

ATTENDANCE IS NECESSARY. You cannot learn if you are not here - physically or remotely. Students are expected to be online during their class period if it is a remote day. If you are not in school or not logged on during class, you will be marked absent by me. This is probably the only place you will hear Spanish, so it is important that you are in class.

Raise your Hand if you are in class and want to speak or get my attention, unless we are doing something where you do not have to.

Use the Chat feature in Google Meet if you are at home remotely learning. I will answer questions as I see them.

Seating Arrangements will be assigned by the teacher. Many of the seats are not going to be able to be used due to social distancing. Please make sure to sit in a seat that is not blocked off.

ALL SCHOOL POLICIES apply in this classroom and our remote classroom. Anything that is in the school handbook applies to our classes, both physically and remotely. Any infraction will be referred to the Vice Principal for discipline.

Oral Participation is Encouraged and Required: Please note, 60% of your grade consists of participation. You will receive a daily and weekly class participation grade. While it may be challenging, I will try to implement speaking activities with you during this time. Speaking is an essential component in learning and using Spanish. All you need to do is TRY speaking Spanish whenever possible.

Work from Absences: Since the work will be in the Google Classroom, you will have access to it the day of your absence. If you are missing from class one day, your work will be due the next class period. If it is more than 1 day, it will be due in as many days as you missed - 2 days = 2 class periods, and so on.

Be Respectful - Have respect for yourself and your peers. If someone is speaking, do not interrupt or criticize. Treat other students the way you would like to be treated in this class. Most of all, if you respect me, I will give you the same respect. We are all learning a new language. Do not be afraid to make a mistake; it's natural. No rudeness will be tolerated.

If you follow these few simple rules, I guarantee that you will have fun in this class. I want you to learn the Spanish language, but I want you to have fun while learning.
