policy for absences & grades

Weekly and daily work will be updated weekly (bell ringers, participation, and homework). Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a particular grade.

If you are not present in class, either physically or remotely, you will be marked absent by me. If you are absent, it is your Responsibility for completing your make-up work (one day for make-up for each day absent).

All make-up work will found in Google Classroom the day you are absent. It is your Responsibility to ask a classmate if there are any notes you missed, and/or to make arrangements with Sra. Creamer to make up any tests.

If you know you are going to be absent beforehand, you should ask me for your make-up work before the absence.

This can be done before or after school or via e-mail.



electronic devices

Phones should be turned off and away in your bookbag. Devices should not be out during class or school.

First offense: Student will turn the phone into the teacher until the end of class.

Second offense: Student will turn the phone into the teacher until the end of day.

Third offense: Phone will be turned into office and parents will have to pick up the device from the office.
