| _____ 5. Back-line | E. Moving the ball along the ground using a pushing movement of the stick after the stick has been placed close to the ball. |
| _____ 6. Goal-line | F. One of the participants on a team |
| _____ 7. Side-boards | G. Striking the ball using a swinging movement of the stick towards the ball. NOT PERMITTED IN INDOOR HOCKEY. |
| _____ 8. Circle | H. The team (player) which is trying to score a goal. |
| _____ 9. Playing the Ball | I. An action contrary to the rules penalized by the umpire. |
| _____ 10. Push | J. The shorter perimeter line. |
| _____ 11. Flick | K. The action of an attacker attempting to score by the playing the ball towards the goal from within the circle. |
| _____ 12. Hit | L. One of the participants on the pitch other than the goalkeeper. |
| _____ 13. Shot on goal | M. The boards comprising the longer perimeter of the pitch. |
| _____ 14. Tackle | N. The back line between the goal posts. |
| _____ 15. Offense | O. The team (player) which is trying to prevent a goal from being scored. |
